## 2010 OUTSTANDING WOMAN IN PHILANTHROPY

### *Nomination Guidelines*

This award honors an Alaska woman whose strategic philanthropy benefits the Anchorage community, furthers YWCA's mission *eliminating racism - empowering women*, and whose generosity encourages others to be philanthropic.

1. Entries for all awards programs must be received by **5 p.m. on Tuesday, March 30, 2010**. Late entries will not be accepted.
2. Nominations must include a completed nomination form and narrative responses to all criteria. Narrative responses must not exceed three (3) pages in length (with 12 point type and 1" margins). Narrative responses, preferably, will be typed; handwritten submissions must be legible.
3. Supporting documents are optional and should enhance rather than be submitted in place of the narrative. No more than five (5) pages of supporting documents are allowed.

### **Award Criteria:**

Nominations will be considered based on responses to the following criteria:

1. Description of philanthropic support of nonprofit organizations in Alaska that further YWCA's mission *eliminating racism, empowering women*. (0-50 points)
2. Demonstrated leadership role in encouraging and motivating others to be philanthropic. (0-30 points)
3. Description of strategic, planned approach to supporting community efforts that reflect the nominee's personal values. (0-20 points)

### **Selection Process**

The award recipient will be determined by a Selection Committee comprised of members of YWCA Anchorage Board of Directors and Empowerment Circle, facilitated by a YWCA Anchorage staff member. The award recipient will be notified of her selection by a member of the Selection Committee in early April, 2010.

### **Presentation of Honors**

The individual selected will be honored at YWCA Anchorage's 2010 Power of Giving event on May 11, 2010. Honoree must be present to receive the award.
